IQAC meeting held on 15-02-2019

Mandal, Teacher-in-Charge and Chairperson of the IQAC committee. The teacher-in-charge and Chairperson of the IQAC initiated the meeting by welcoming the external members of the IQAC which was followed with agenda-wise discussion among the members.

Proceedings and Resolutions of the Meeting:

- The first agenda related to the academic and research activities went for a thorough discussion and the following resolutions were adopted.
 - a. It was resolved that the examination process for all the internal college examinations including the CBCS curriculum be reviewed from the academic session 2019-2020 and the students will have to ensure a clear way out in the exams else they will debarred from sitting in the university examinations. The students under the CBCS curriculum will also have to ensure a clear attendance in the class.
 - b. The need for some career oriented certificate courses was taken into consideration and the members agreed to provide an opportunity to the students which will be taken care of via the Academic sub-committee and Career counseling cell.
 - c. The members also resolved for the introduction of interdepartmental faculty exchange lectures outside the schedule routine and also opined for invited lectures from other colleges and institutes where the students from other schools could also add to the beneficiaries. The schedule for such lectures will be taken care of by the Academic sub-committee.
 - d. The members agreed that value added programmes should be implemented on a regular basis as suggested by the NAAC PEER team and its focus could be on the Nabadwip centric study circle.
 - e. The mechanism for analysis of feedback from students needs to be evaluated and scrutinized and necessary steps should be taken with immediate effect from the upcoming session (2019-2020).
 - f. As suggested by the NAAC PEER team the need for a research centric atmosphere should be augmented and the Research sub-committee to take immediate steps in this regard.
 - g. It was also resolved that the present convener of Teachers' journal should expedite the process for the electronic version of the journal and publication of regular issues.
 - h. The members agreed for a MoU with academic bodies and other institutes for a proper orientation among the students and teachers.
- The second agenda for the meeting was the discussion of infrastructural and technological aspects related to the action plan for the session 2018-2019 and it was resolved that the infrastructure subcommittee is going to take care of the related issues.
- The members decided to reconsider the extension of the IQAC regarding some additional external members.

The meeting ended with the coordinator extending thanks to all the members of the IQAC.
